ACADEMICS: PREPARATORY

A modern, relevant curriculum using CAPS as a base. A big emphasis is placed on an integrated, project-based learning programme. STEAM, Robotics and Coding have been built into the daily timetable. A new, integrated testing system is currently being implemented.

Junior Preparatory (Grade 1 – 3):

The balanced and broad curriculum comprises the following learning areas:

English (home language), Afrikaans (first additional language), isiZulu (second additional language), Mathematics, Computer and Technology Skills, Life Skills, Art, STEAM, Music and Physical Education

Senior Preparatory (Grade 4 – 6):

English, Mathematics, History, Life Orientation, Afrikaans, Natural Science, Geography, Art/Drama, STEAM

Grade 7:

English, Mathematics, EMS, Social Science (Geography & History), Afrikaans, Science, Biology, Art/Drama, Divinity, STEAM

All the students from Grade 1 to 7 develop computer skills and follow the Resolute Education Coding and Robotics programme in the Computer Lab and STEAM Lab.
